

Message from the Principal

It's a pleasure to introduce this book series for the students as a guide to practise English speaking. This booklet is the first part

of the speaking English book series which have three books called level 1, level 2, level 3. It is compulsory for grade 6,7,8,9 students to use this booklet and get ready for the English oral test at the term tests to score 15 marks. It will be increased to 20 marks in 2019.

Any other student who is interested in obtaining a certificate can refer the content and walk in for an interview. Certificate will be awarded at a special felicitation ceremony.

At the same time "English as a Life Skill Club" will be established to develop English speaking in the college. A sixty day programme will be carried out at the smart classes. It will be an after school session with evaluation after 8 lessons. The one who will pass all the levels will be awarded with a certificate.


