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Instructions to the teacher

- Distribute the task sheets (Annexure) to the students and allow them to go through it for 1-2 minutes.

 - First reading - at normal conversational speed (ask students not to write answers but to listen)
 - Second reading - chunk by chunk for the students to complete the task
 - Third reading - again at normal conversational speed for the students to check their answers

Steps

1. Third reading begins after a pause of 1 minute after the second reading.
2. At the end of the third reading, there will be a pause of two minutes. (for the students to complete the task)
3. Tell the students that the test is over.
