- Distribute the task sheets (Annexure) to the students and allow them to go through it for 1-2 minutes.
- · Read the text for 3 times.

First reading

- at normal conversational speed (ask students not to writeanswers but to listen)

Second readin

- chunk by chunk for the students to complete the task

Third reading

- again at normal conversational speed for the students tocheck their answers

Steps

- 1. Third reading begins after a pause of 1 minute after the second reading.
- 2. At the end of the third reading, there will be a pause of two minutes. (for the students to complete the task)
- 3. Tell the students that the test is over.
